Introduction and Purpose of the Request for Quote (RFQ)

HISTORY: St. Petersburg College (“SPC” or the “College”), located in Pinellas County, Florida, and established in 1927, is one of the oldest colleges in the 28-institution Florida College System (“FCS”). SPC is the first college in the FCS to become a four-year college issuing baccalaureate degrees beginning in 2001. SPC is governed by a five-member Board of Trustees appointed to four-year terms by the Governor of Florida. The Board of Trustees appoints the College President who has administrative responsibilities for college operations.

ACADEMICS: Enrollment in 2016-2017 included 49,006 students, including 40,661 credit seeking and 8,345 non-credit seeking (Source: spcollege.edu). St. Petersburg College offers more than 100 academic programs, career training, and university transfer options at twelve locations throughout Pinellas County and online.

REQUEST FOR QUOTE: St. Petersburg College’s Center for Public Safety Innovation is soliciting proposals from companies experienced and qualified to deliver an existing web-based course titled *AfterMath ~ Lessons in School Safety* via a downloadable mobile application. The successful quote would include the comprehensive delivery and testing of the AfterMath course available via the mobile app platform and that could be readily available to students not later than September 15, 2018.

PROJECT NEED: St. Petersburg College’s CPSI currently has a web based course that will need to be available via a mobile app. The AfterMath mobile app will be a full featured mobile application that will have all the functionality implemented from the original project specifications. Currently the Aftermath project is a self-contained website consisting of 6 folders, 308 files with a weight of 531 megabytes. We are requesting a cross platform hybrid developed application that will work on iOS, Android, and Windows devices in their most recent versions applicable as well as mobile devices using a browser pulling the web app version. The cross platform development will need to cover all IOS, Android, and Windows platforms on any mobile devices that can view a web application online. This mobile application will need to work on networks and platforms in North America, South America, and Europe. This application will need to be developed for Data Caching in order to work in an offline mode. This application should receive geological data upon download so CPSI can track the most geological use in order to market additional

training to those specific areas. The link to the course can be found below. Aftermath is currently a self-contained HTML5 website.
