## Answers to Questions received for RFQ SCP #11-19-20

1. Regarding RFQ 11-19-20, can you please clarify what is to be included in Tab B. Financial Capability? Is the financial statement to be included as a separate document, as indicated in Sections H and I, or should it be included within the proposal and as a separate document?

The financial statement should be included as a separate document. There is no need to duplicate efforts by also inserting your company's financial statement within the proposal.

2. Is the Appendix B "Letter of Intent" form actually "Appendix F"?

Appendix F contains a Letter of Intent form that should be submitted by your surety company on the surety company's letterhead.

3. While I understand both projects are in the development phase, is there any projected target construction dates (start and finish) for the two projects currently out for RFQ?

Targeted project start date for both projects will be approximately a month after achieving Board RFQ approval. The CM@Risk project RFQ# 11-19-20 at the Downtown campus is projected to start in June, 2020. The DB project RFQ#12-19-20 at the Clearwater Campus- BT building is projected to start in July, 2020. Architectural firms have estimated a 6 month completion from the start date.

4. Please clarify whether this RFQ is meant to solicit qualifications for a 3-year continuing Construction Management service contract (see page 3 of the RFQ) or the CM services for a specific renovation to occur at the Downtown Center (see page 9 of the RFQ).
